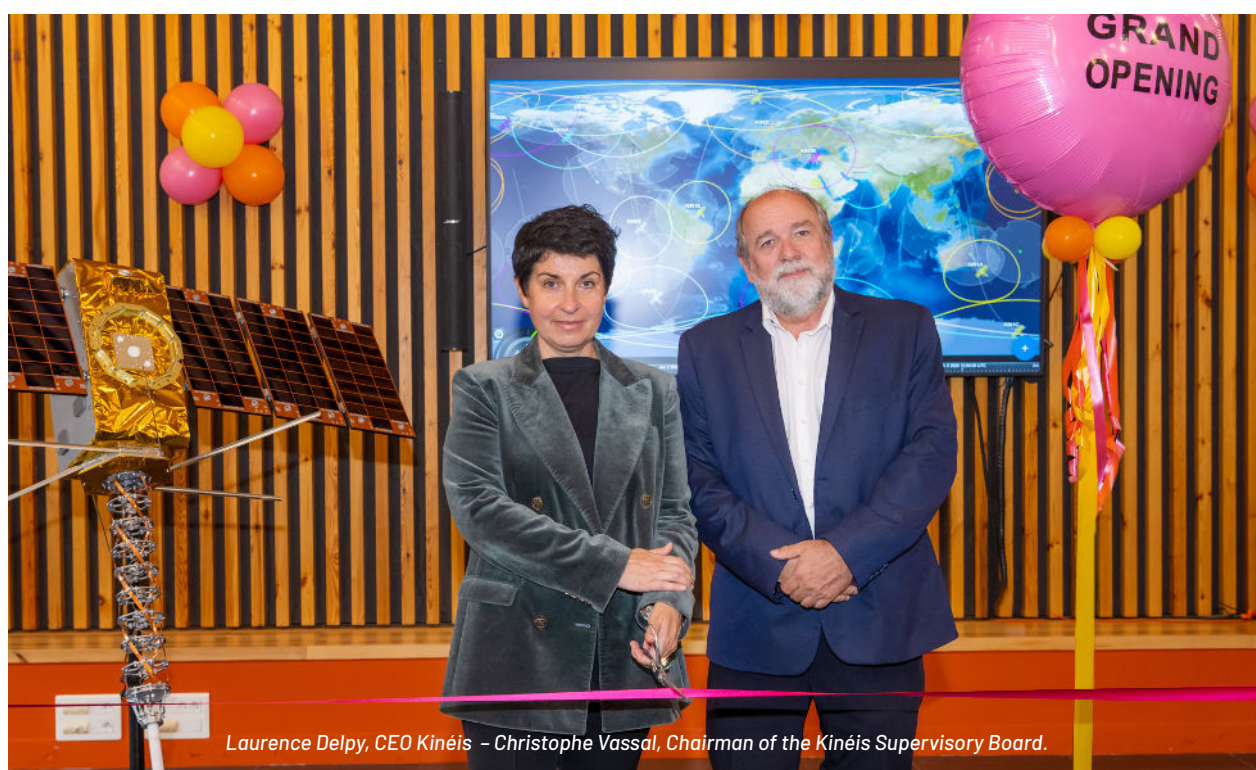
KINÉIS, READY TO COLLECT CRITICAL DATA - ANYWHERE, ANYTIME
